As Arkansas's primary commercial aviation gateway, Clinton National Airport (LIT) supports business, tourism, and everyday travel across the region. The Airport is planning terminal improvements to better serve our region and support the long-term future of air travel in Arkansas.

As this planning begins, the Airport wants to hear directly from the community about what matters most. Input from travelers, nearby residents, and local partners will help shape decisions and guide long-term improvements at this critical moment.

WHY ARE WE HAVING THIS MEETING?

The purpose of this meeting is to present renderings for a new Arrivals Hall as part of planning for future growth and improvements at the Airport. The renderings shown are for illustrative purposes only and do not represent the final design. The project is still in the conceptual stage, and the design will continue to evolve over the next 12-18 months. Community members, nearby residents, passengers, and local partners are invited to share their thoughts and ideas. Feedback collected through this meeting will help shape decisions and guide future improvements.
